NOTICE TO MUNICIPAL ELECTORS OF TOWNSHIPS OF CENTRAL FRONTENAC AND NORTH FRONTENAC

INTERESTED IN RUNNING FOR MUNICIPAL OFFICE?

Nominations for the positions listed below must be made on the prescribed form available at your municipal Office. Nomination forms must be signed by the candidate and may be filed in person or by an agent, with the Returning Officer of the appropriate municipality during normal office hours between January 4, 2010 and September 10, 2010 (Nomination Day). Please note that filing on Nomination Day (September 10, 2010) is between 9:00 a.m. and 2:00 p.m.

A prescribed nomination filing fee (\$200 for Head of Council and \$100 for all other offices) in cash, certified cheque or money order made payable to the appropriate municipality must accompany the signed nomination form. Full details on the procedures to be followed may be obtained from your Clerk. A nomination must be certified by the Clerk or designate in the applicable municipal office before such person becomes a certified candidate for the office to which she or he is nominated.

Additional information for candidates can be viewed on the municipal websites or picked up at your municipal office during regular office hours.
