**COUNCIL MEETINGS** are usually held the 2<sup>nd</sup> and the 4<sup>th</sup> Tuesday of each month with the Committee of the Whole meeting at 4:00p.m. and the Council meeting at 7:00p.m. in Sharbot Lake. To address Council, please call the office by noon on the Thursday prior to the meeting to have your name placed on the agenda. The Council agenda can be accessed on the Web Site after 4:00p.m. on the Friday prior to the meeting.

Dog tags can be obtained, either in person or by mail at the municipal office, Sharbot Lake. **The cost is \$9.00 per dog if paid before June 30<sup>th</sup> and \$20.00 per dog after July 1<sup>st</sup>.**

**BAG TAGS AND TIPPING FEES**

Bag tags are \$1.00 each and available in sheets of 10. Waste must be bagged, boxed or bundled and a **bag tag affixed to it**. A standard bag, box or bundle is 26" X 36".

Bag Tags may be used at the site for tipping fees **AND** must be affixed to the article. Clean lumber and brush will be accepted at no charge if placed on the burn pile at 10180 Road 38 site. The refrigerant must be removed from refrigerators, air conditioners and freezers by a licensed person and the appropriate label affixed to the item. Bag Tags are **NOT** required for recycled items. **PERMITTED RECYCLABLE ITEMS** – PAPER PRODUCTS – newspaper, magazines, flyers, catalogues, household paper, cardboard, cereal boxes, cardboard egg cartons, envelopes, soft cover books (do not include hard cover books, wax coated cardboard, wax covered boxboard, construction paper, Christmas wrap). CANS – aluminum and tin food and beverage containers (do not include scrap metal). PLASTIC – plastic container with a recycling symbol on the bottom (do not include plastic without a recycling symbol, foam padding, Styrofoam, plastic film). GLASS – clear and coloured glass bottles and jars (do not include dishes, ceramics or window glass). Tipping fees and bag tags are available at the municipal office during normal office hours or can be mailed upon written request and receipt of the payment. Bag tags are also available at the waste disposal sites in sheets of 10. Payment by cheque is preferred. Winter and Summer hours of operation are available on the web site at [www.centralfrontenac.com/works](http://www.centralfrontenac.com/works). Winter hours are in effect from December 1<sup>st</sup> to March 1<sup>st</sup>, during which time waste sites are closed by 5p.m.

\*\*\*\*\*HOUSEHOLD HAZARDOUS WASTE\*\*\*\*\*

The Township of Central Frontenac is hosting a **Free Household Hazardous Waste day Saturday, July 24, 2010.**

*10:00 a.m. to 3:00 p.m.*

**South/West Intersection of Road #38 and Hwy #7, Sharbot Lake (Plaza Parking Lot)**

As an alternative residents can purchase a permit for a fee of \$26.25 and dispose of Household Hazardous Waste Disposal Site located at 70 Lappan's Lane, Kingston (Turn north off Counter Street at the PUC building onto Lappan's Lane). Site Hours – Beginning of April to end of November – Thursday 9:00 a.m. – 2:00 p.m., 2<sup>nd</sup> Saturday of each month 9:00 a.m. – 2:00 p.m. Waste accepted at the site: paint, motor oil, car batteries, household batteries, propane cylinders, flammable, antifreeze, acid (Muratic, etc.), caustic (detergents), oxidizers, fertilizer, pesticides, medications and needles. The fee and a form listing items to be taken must be paid at the Municipal Office, Sharbot Lake before going to the Kingston Site.

**BURNING PERMITS** – From April 1st to October 31st permits will be required for any open air burning. Fees - Incinerators \$5.00/season, Campfires - \$2.00/season, Brush/yard pile \$2.00/occasion. Permits cannot be obtained and therefore no burning is allowed of buildings, hay, straw, tires or any materials restricted by the Ministry of the Environment. Negligence or carelessness regarding any fire may result in a fine of up to \$5,000.00 plus all costs associated with extinguishing the fire. **BUILDING PERMITS** – Please contact the Building Department at the Municipal Office or [www.centralfrontenac.com/building\\_department.aspx](http://www.centralfrontenac.com/building_department.aspx) to determine when a Building Permit is required for construction, renovations and demolition, as well as for the installation of chimneys, wood stoves, furnaces and swimming pools. A 'Change of Use Permit' is required whenever the use of a building is changed even if there is no construction proposed.

**WELL WATER TESTING** To inquire about well water testing please contact the Public Health – 613-279-2151.

**2010 FINAL TAX BILL** - There are two installments to this bill and the due dates for each installment are printed on the tax notice. Penalty of 1.25% will be added after due dates for late payments. The bill is 2 pages, with page 1 being your payment stubs and page 2 for your information. Please return the appropriate stub(s) with your payment. Receipts are only mailed if you return all pages and request a receipt. **PRE-AUTHORIZED PAYMENT (PAP) IS AVAILABLE** – the form is available at [www.centralfrontenac.com/treasury\\_tax.aspx](http://www.centralfrontenac.com/treasury_tax.aspx) or at the township office. If you are already set up on PAP, the bill is for information only. A \$25.00 fee is charged for all returned payments. **2010 MUNICIPAL ELECTION**

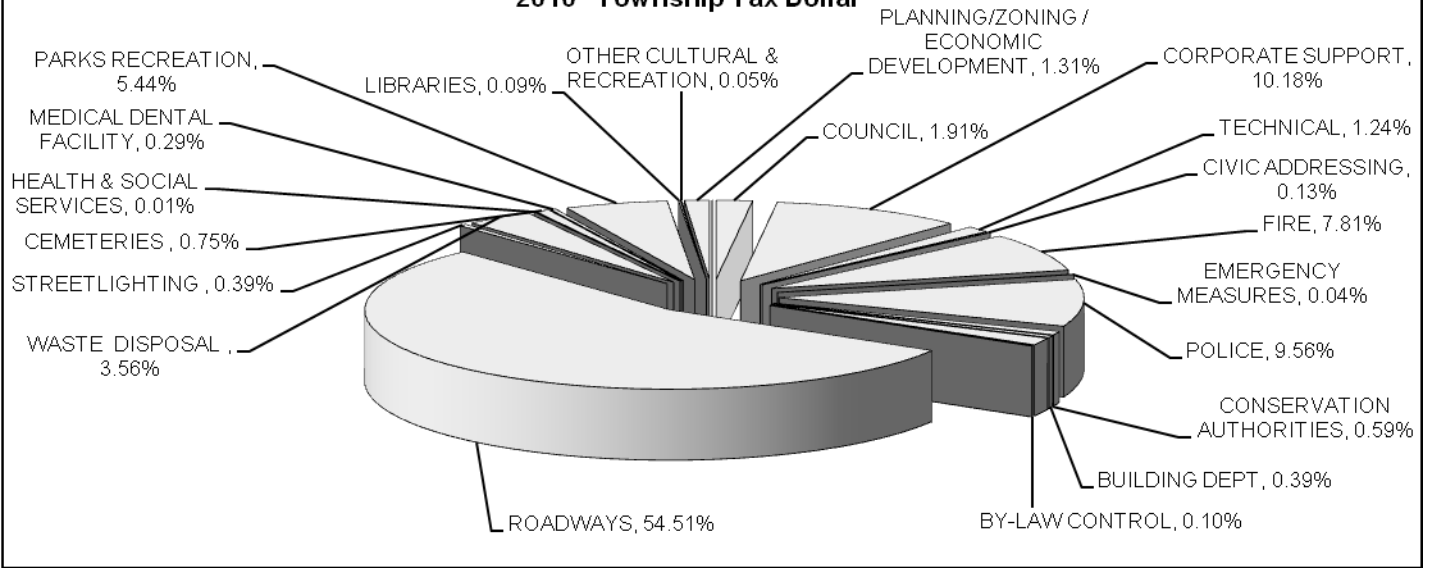
**MUNICIPAL ELECTION DAY, OCTOBER 25, 2010.**

Council member positions in Central Frontenac include the Mayor (elected at large across the township) and 8 Councillors (elected by ward - 2 councillors per ward. The wards include Kennebec, Olden Oso and Hinchinbrooke).

The closing day and time for nominations is September 10 at 2:00 p.m.

The vote will be conducted by **Mail in Ballot**. Voter Kits, including appropriate ballots will be mailed to all electors during the last week in September. Prepaid secrecy envelopes with enclosed ballots are to be returned to the municipality for counting. 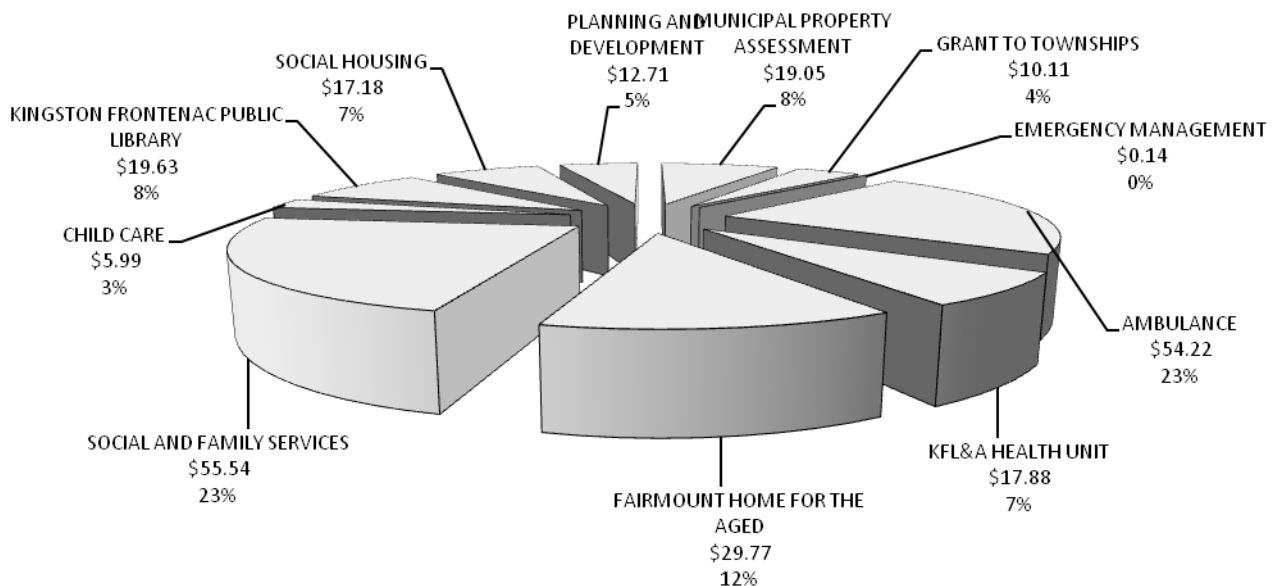
