By-Law #2022-09

Being a By-Law to request a question on the ballot for the 2022 municipal election

Whereas pursuant to Section 217(1) of the *Municipal Act, 2001, S.O. 2001 Chapter 25* council may change the composition of its council provided there is a minimum of five (5) members;

And Whereas The Corporation of the Township of Central Frontenac (the "Township") is considering whether to reduce the number of members of council from nine members to five, and held a public meeting November 16, 2021 to seek public input.

And Whereas the Township passed Resolution 437-2021 on November 23, 2022 to include this question on the ballot for the 2022 election;

And Whereas pursuant to Section 8(1) (b) of *The Municipal Elections Act, 1996, S.O. 1996, c. 32, Sched.* The council of a municipality may pass a by-law to submit to its electors, a question not otherwise authorized by law but within the council's jurisdiction;


Now therefore, The Council of the Corporation of the Township of Central Frontenac enacts as follows:

1. That the Clerk/Returning Officer is hereby authorized and directed to place a question on the ballot for the 2022 Municipal Election for the Township of Central Frontenac pursuant to the requirements of the Municipal Elections Act, 1996 as follows:


***Are you in favour of reducing Council size from 9 members to 5 members?
Yes or No***

2. That this by-law come into full force and effect on the day it is passed.

Read a first, second, and third time and passed this 22nd day of February, 2022.
