On April 14, 2020, the Ontario government extended the Declaration of Emergency under the <i>Emergency Management and Civil Protection Act (EMCPA)</i> until May 12, 2020.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • For the most up-to-date information on the provincial declaration and emergency orders please go to: https://www.ontario.ca/page/emergency-information. <p>Provincial Emergency Operations Centre (PEOC) response:</p> <p>b. The PEOC has updated the Question and Answer document to address common issues and inquiries across the province.</p> <p>Provincial response:</p> <p>c. The governments of Canada and Ontario are investing \$2.25 million in provincially licensed meat processing plants to better protect employees and ensure the continued supply of healthy products for consumers during the COVID-19 outbreak.</p> <p>d. The Ontario government is opening provincial parks and conservation reserves for limited day-use access. The first areas opened today, May 11, 2020, with the remaining areas opening on Friday May 15, 2020. At this time, recreational activities will be limited to walking, hiking, biking and birdwatching. Day visitors will also be able to access all parks and conservation reserves for free until the end of the month. The status of provincial parks can be found here.</p> <p>e. Retail stores with a street entrance to offer curbside pickup and delivery began to open today in Ontario. Over the weekend, garden centres, nurseries, hardware stores and safety supply stores began offering in-store purchasing. All retailers should follow available safety guidelines in order to protect staff, consumers and the general public during the COVID-19 outbreak.</p> <p>Health sector response:</p> <p>f. <p>a. The PEOC will continue to conduct coordination calls with federal, provincial and municipal stakeholders. Information shared in these calls will drive future planning efforts.</p> <p>b. The PEOC will continue to conduct contingency planning with key Indigenous partners as well as federal, provincial, municipal and other stakeholders in relation to the impact of the COVID-19 outbreak on flood and forest fire response.</p> <p>c. The PEOC will continue to coordinate information requirements from provincial and municipal partners.</p>
