

THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWNSHIP OF CENTRAL FRONTENAC

BY-LAW #2004-156

Being a by-law for the establishment of and the enforcement of parking regulations in the Township of Central Frontenac.

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WHEREAS Section 11 of the Municipal Act, 2001, authorizes municipalities to enact by-laws respecting matters within the sphere of jurisdiction of highways, including parking, in conjunction with the provisions of the Highway Traffic Act.

NOW THEREFORE the Council of the Corporation of the Township of Central Frontenac hereby enacts as follows:

1. DEFINITIONS:

“Owner” means the registered owner of a motor vehicle.

“Park” or “Parking” when prohibited means the standing of a vehicle, whether occupied or not, except when standing temporarily for the purpose of and while actually engaged in loading or unloading merchandise or passengers.

“Signs” or “Parking Signs” means words, numbers or symbols erected in prominent locations which describe and explain the conditions of parking regulations.

2. APPLICATION:

This by-law applies to every highway over which the Township of Central Frontenac has jurisdiction or, in the case of a boundary highway, joint jurisdiction.

This by-law does not apply to a provincial highway or to a private road.

3. PARKING REGULATIONS:

(1) No person or owner shall park or permit to be parked a vehicle on a highway or parts of highways as follows:

.1 In the Village of Sharbot Lake, on Elizabeth Street, on the west side of the street from a point opposite the north west corner of Lot 22 to the north east corner of Lot 91, and from the north west corner of Lot 14 to the south east corner of Lot 15.

.2 In the Village of Sharbot Lake on Elizabeth Street on the east side of the street from the north west corner of Lot 22 to the south west corner of Lot 20.

.3 In the Village of Sharbot lake on Garrett Street from the north west corner of Lot 40 to the south west corner of Lot 39.

.4 In the Village of Sharbot Lake on Garrett Street from 15 metres north of the south east corner of Lot 19 to such corner and on Elizabeth Street from such corner, north 10 metres.

.5 In the Village of Sharbot Lake on Matthew Street from the north east corner of Lot 15 to the south east corner of Lot 9 and on Matthew Street from a point opposite the north east corner of Lot 15 to a point opposite the south east corner of Lot 9.

.6 In the Village of Sharbot Lake, on Dixon Crescent, from where the northerly extension of Dixon Crescent intersects Road #38, on both sides of Dixon Crescent for a length of 40 metres in an easterly direction.

.7 In the Village of Parham on the north side of Wagarville Road from the corner of Road 38 and the Wagarville Road to a point 10 feet east of the driveway at 1256 Wagarville Road.

.8 In the Village of Parham on the south side of Wagarville Road from the Long Lake Road to a point directly across from 10 feet east of the driveway at 1256 Wagarville Road.

- (2) No person or owner shall park or permit to be parked a vehicle on a highway or parts of highways for a period of time greater than two (2) hours between the hours of 7:00 a.m. and 6:00 p.m.

.1 In the Village of Sharbot Lake on Elizabeth Street from the south east corner of Lot 37 to the north west corner of Lot 16 excluding areas where parking is restricted completely.

.2 In the Village of Sharbot Lake on Elizabeth Street from the north west corner of Lot 91 to the south east corner of Lot 2.

- (3) No Person shall park a vehicle on a highway or parts of a highway at any time when such parking may obstruct or interfere with the removal of snow, or the maintenance of the highway by municipal equipment or work crews.
- (4) From November 15<sup>th</sup> in any year until March 31<sup>st</sup> of the following year, no vehicle shall be parked between the hours of 12:00 midnight and 7:00 a.m. on any highway within the limits of the Corporation of the Township of Central Frontenac.
- (5) No person shall park a vehicle on a highway or parts of a highway at any time where the parked vehicle obstructs, or interferes with, the open access to and from public or private laneways.

#### 4. PENALTIES:

(1) Any person who contravenes this by-law is guilty of an offence and, upon conviction, is subject to a fine as provided in the Provincial Offences Act or the Highway Traffic Act and to any other applicable penalties.

(2) Any vehicle of any owner found in violation of this by-law may be towed to a municipal property or compound at the expense of the owner. All costs shall be received prior to release of such vehicles so removed. The municipality shall not be held liable for any damage or costs which may be incurred by such towing or removal.

THIS BY-LAW rescinds all previous parking by-laws of the former municipalities within the Township of Central Frontenac.

APPENDIX "A"

TO BY-LAW #2004-156

WHEREAS By-law #2004-156, being a by-law for the establishment of and the enforcement of parking regulations in the Township of Central Frontenac, was passed and became effective on April 13, 2004;

AND WHEREAS it is deemed necessary to prohibit parking on the east side of the Arden Road from the Elm Tree Road to Arden Gardens Trail;

NOW THEREFORE the Township of Central Frontenac hereby prohibits parking as outlined below and further that all definitions and penalties enacted under By-law 2004-156 shall be of the same force and effect for this Appendix "A"

1. No person or owner shall park or permit to be parked a vehicle on a highway or parts of highways as follows:
  - .1 In the Village of Arden, on the East side of Arden Road from the Elm Tree Road to Arden Gardens Trail
