Central Frontenac sends two (2) tax bills each year. Each bill is divided into two (2) installments. Please include the enclosed payment stub(s) if mailing your payment. Penalty of 1.25% per month is charged on all past-due amounts whether a tax notice is received or not. A \$25.00 fee is charged for all returned payments.

All dogs require a licence which is renewed annually. Please visit our website or contact the office for fees, instructions on how to obtain a licence, or to update the status of your dog. To report a dog at large – Frontenac By-Law Enforcement 613-541-3213 and leave a message.



All non-recyclable waste is accepted in clear Township stamped bags ONLY, which can be purchased at the Township office or at each waste site. Black garbage bags ARE NOT accepted at any waste site.

Hazardous waste can be disposed of at the South Frontenac Hazardous Waste Depot located at 2491 Keeley Road. For information regarding hours of operation please visit our website.

Property Clean Up Tickets can be obtained by sending an email request to waste@centralfrontenac.com or by calling the Township office. Property Clean up tickets may be sent by mail or email at your request and must be submitted to the site attendant upon your arrival at the waste site. One ticket per property (vacant land does not qualify for a property clean up ticket) & REPLACEMENT TICKETS WILL NOT BE ISSUED.



Fire Permits are required year-round for all outdoor burning. Please note: There are time restrictions when burning between April 1st and October 31st. All fire permits are now obtained by visiting <https://centralfrontenacfire.burnpermits.com/>

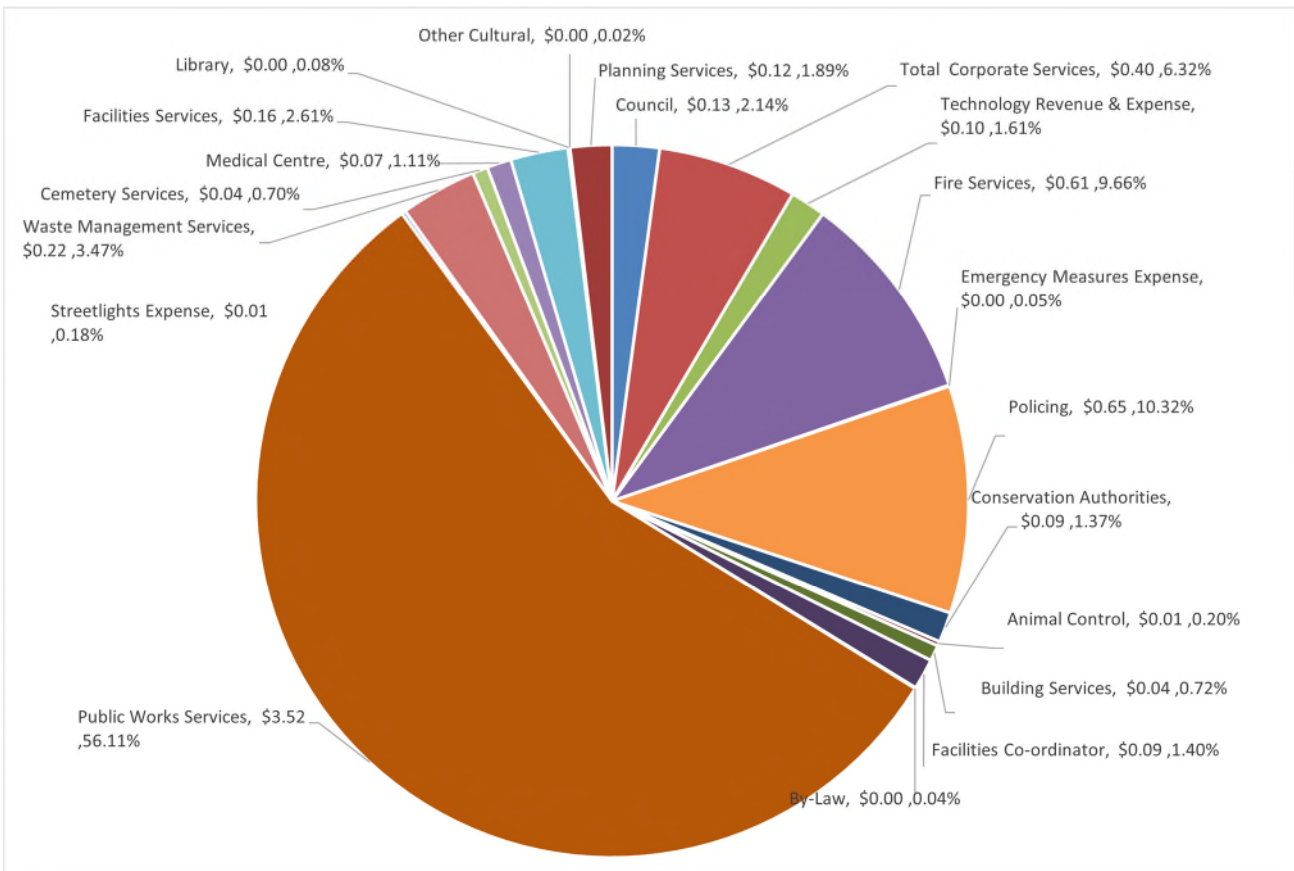
Please check the burn ban status before starting any burning. If you are unable to access this site or have questions, please contact the office.



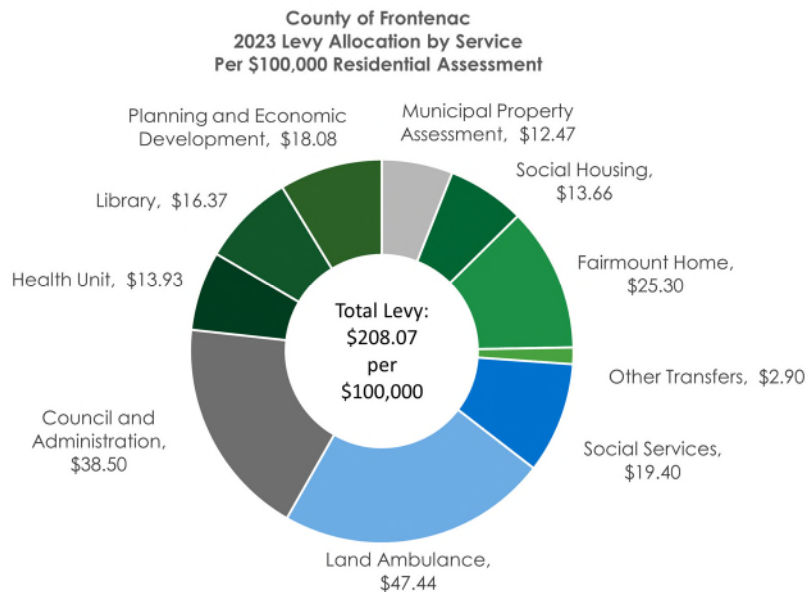
Please contact the Building Department to determine when a building permit is required for your project: ie. construction, renovations/demolitions, chimney installation, wood stoves and swimming pools. A ‘Change of Use Permit’ is required whenever the use of a building is changed even when no construction is proposed.
